GANA Re-Approves Informational Bulletins

(TOPEKA) - The Glass Association of North America (GANA) announced today that two of its Glass Informational Bulletins (GIB) were re-approved after the customary five year review process modeled after that of ASTM International. *Heat-Treated Glass Surfaces Are Different* and *Construction Site Protection of Architectural Glass* were both reapproved by GANA's Tempering Division.

"Our review process calls for all GANA GIB's to be reviewed and either reapproved or modified every five years," said Brian Pitman, Director of Marketing and Communications for GANA. "The GANA Tempering Division felt that both these documents, originally published in 2002 and 2003, still provided excellent information for the industry in which we serve."
