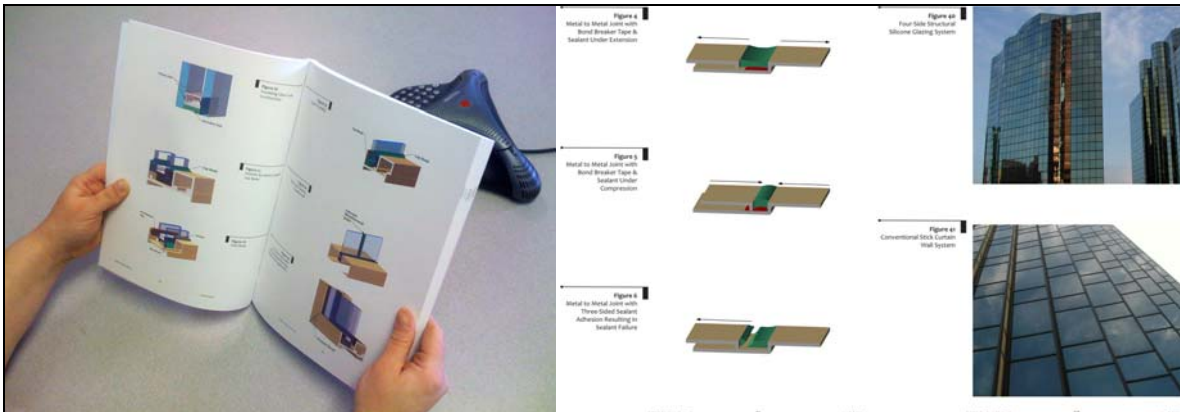
GANA Sealant Manual Goes on Sale
