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## Window, Door and Skylight Market Study Available

SCHAUMBURG, Ill -- The 2006 AAMA/WDMA *U.S. Industry Statistical Review and Forecast*, researched by the Ducker Research Company is now available from the American Architectural Manufacturers Association (AAMA) and the Window and Door Manufacturers Association (WDMA). The study provides the most detailed residential and non-residential market information available on the fenestration industry, as well as providing annual tracking of industry sales by window and door types and materials used (reported in units sold), updates on construction activity, skylights and insulating glass statistics, and non-residential data by building type and application (reported in square feet of vision area).

This is an update of one report included in the full five-part research study, which is published in even years. Issued in May 2006, the full report price is \$3,300 for non-members (\$100 for AAMA members). The report can also be purchased in the following segments:
